Fair Dates: February 24 – March 6, 2022

'HONORING HOMETOWN HEROES'

The Southwest Florida and Lee County Fair extends an invitation to all Lee County schools, teachers, and students to display their artwork, student projects, photography, Vo-tech projects, culinary arts, or horticulture projects. This is a great way to motivate and reward your students' efforts, as well as take part in this Annual Event honoring our County, its history and growth.

DIVISIONS, JUDGING, AND AWARDS

Competition is divided into four (4) divisions: Elementary School, Middle School, High School, and Vocational/Special Learning Centers, and judged on the following criteria:

- Theme/ Booth Title – 10 % - Booth should demonstrate a use of the theme in the title.
- Educational Use of Theme – 10 % - Theme should be incorporated into the booth display.
- Durability – 15 % - Display/booth should be sturdy and durable to withstand the duration of the Fair.
- Originality – 20 % - Booth should be pleasing to the eye, and should use creative and new ideas.
- Overall Appearance – 15 % - Booth must be attractive, simple, and neat.
- Student-made Work Contributions - 30 % - Booth must show evidence of student participation. This can be demonstrated through pictures, artwork, student projects, research papers, etc. The more evidence of student works the greater the score.

Booths will be judged and awarded in each division, as follows: 1st Place in Each Division - \$500, Blue Rosette; 2nd Place in each Division - \$300, Red Rosette; 3rd Place in each Division - \$200, White Rosette.

General Rules:

1. Registration for the School Booth Competitive Exhibits competition is open to any Lee County school.
2. All booth exhibits must include the school name *and the 2022 Fair Theme 'HONORING HOMETOWN HEROES'.*
3. Booth set up hours are between 9am – 7pm, - Tuesday and Wednesday, February 22 & 23, 2022. Booth size is 10'x10'. *Power is accessible, but schools must supply their own 100' heavy duty extension cord.*
4. Booths must be ready for viewing by 7pm on Wednesday, February 23rd and *remain in place until 4 pm on Sunday, March 6th. **Early tear down is prohibited*** and will result in forfeiture of participation the following year. All booths must be vacated between the hours of 4pm and 7pm on Sunday, March 6, 2022.
5. The doors to the Lee Civic Center remain open until 10pm nightly and all booth materials must be secure due to the occasional windy environment of the building.
6. Booths will be judged on Thursday, February 24th prior to the Fair opening. Students nor faculty members are permitted inside the Lee Civic Center during the judging process.

Registration Deadline is February 11, 2022, and space is limited.
