



2023 Southwest Florida & Lee County Fair 4-H/FFA Club Booth Agreement

Theme: BARN IN THE USA

Booth Competition is open to any current Lee, Charlotte, Collier, DeSoto, Glades, and Hendry County 4-H/FFA Club

- All 4-H/FFA Club booths will be set up inside the Lee Civic Center on Tuesday, February 21, 2023 and Wednesday, February 22, 2023 from 9am-7pm. Club exhibits must remain intact until 4:00pm on Sunday, March 5, 2023. Lattice will not be provided. STRAW MAY BE USED IF PLASTIC OR SHEETING IS PLACED UNDERNEATH AND THE STRAW IS CLEANED UP. NO GLITTER OR CONFETTI. Each club booth will be in an area measuring 10' X 10'. Larger space may be reserved if requested *and available*.
- The exhibit must contain project articles made by the club members, and projects must be registered online under the exhibitor's name. All booths will be inspected for completeness including attractiveness, simplicity, and neatness. Project books may be exhibited in the booth but are not required. If project books are exhibited, it must be the book the member has used.
- Per 4-H, Exhibitor projects within the booths will NOT be judged this year. Premiums to the clubs will be paid by check and mailed to the Exhibitor after the close out of the Fair.
- Club Leader will register as 'Exhibitor' and then proceed to registering for the booth competition.
- 4-H Exhibitors must register separately, online, for the projects in the booths.

Overall Judging Criteria:

25% Education
25% Originality
25% Appearance
25% Use of the Fair Booth Theme – 'BARN IN THE USA'

Premiums:

1st - Blue Rosette, \$150
2nd - Red Rosette, \$100
3rd - White Rosette, \$75

Each Club Booth area is to be cleaned and left in satisfactory condition. All display materials and trash must be promptly removed by the club on **Sunday, March 5, 2023, after 4:00pm.**
