2026 LIVESTOCK EXHIBITOR YOUTH SCHOLARSHIP

The **Livestock Exhibitor Youth Scholarship** is sponsored by the Southwest Florida and Lee County Fair Association, Inc. and is open to current high school seniors residing in Charlotte, Collier, DeSoto, Glades, Henry, or Lee County, and having participated in 4 years in the Open Exhibit division of the Fair Industry – in your Local, District, or State Fair.

Award of Scholarship: A total of \$2,500 (a min of \$500 and up to a max of \$2,500) is available to be distributed for the Fall term of the year of qualifying. Scholarship funds are paid directly to the school upon proper documentation of school registration and course selection. Funds may be applied to a Trade School Program or College Program.

Eligibility Requirements:

- Applicant must be a current high school senior residing in Charlotte, Collier, DeSoto, Glades, Henry, or Lee County. This includes seniors who are concurrently dual enrolled in a college.
- Applicant must have participated in 4 years in the Livestock Exhibitor division of the **Fair Industry** – in your local, District or State **Fair**;
- Applicant must hold a 3.0 GPA;
- Applicant must submit a complete application packet, by email, no later than April 7, 2026. Applications received after April 7, 2026, will not be accepted.

Complete Application Packet: Completed applications must include three (3) **formal** letters of recommendation and the student's most recent grade-ending report card – **the report card must show your GPA**. Recommendation letters should be from diverse backgrounds. Example: 4-H, School, Business or Community Leader.

Award Criteria: **See Page 2 of application for specifics and clarification for each category.**

- 15% - Years, range of entries, and accomplishments in the *Livestock Division (i.e. Small Animals, Goats, Beef, Swine, etc.) of your Local, District, or State Fair – by Year*;
- 10% - High School extracurricular activities throughout High School, by year.
- 25%- Essay – 300 word minimum – relating to **this** scholarship.
- 10% - Community Involvement and Volunteer Service Hours – not 4-H/FFA related, by year.
- 15% - Number of Years and Involvement in 4-H / FFA, by year.
- 20% - Thoroughness, completeness, formatting, and neatness of application.

Evaluation: Applications are evaluated by the Scholarship Evaluation Committee based on Criteria provided. The non-weighted GPA will be added to the score to determine final points. All decisions are final.

Due Date: April 7, 2026. Applications received after April 7, 2026, will not be accepted.

Scholarship/Award Criteria:

Below are the criteria to be considered for the Livestock Youth *Exhibitor Scholarship*. Information must be submitted in a **typed font of your choice, but no smaller than 12 pt.** The application must be **submitted as one document**, in the **order of requirements including cover page, recommendation letters, all answers and each page should be numbered.** Margins should be a minimum of ½” on all four edges. **You will also need to include a senior picture for promotion of awards if you are awarded scholarship money.** Points will be deducted for missing components, formatting, thoroughness, and completeness. Please make sure that you have included all of the required information in the format given. **

1. **15%** - Provide information on your number of years, entries, and accomplishments in the **Livestock Division** (*i.e. Small Animals, Goats, etc.*) of your Local, District, or State Fair – by Year;.
2. **10%** - List and describe **High School Extracurricular Activities** – including leadership roles, awards, and honors. Extracurricular Activities would include, but is not limited to high school clubs, high school teams, high school committees, and positions/offices held.
3. **25%** - Essay – 300 word minimum – write an essay about yourself, your experiences, and accomplishments in the **Livestock Division.** **Essay must be related to this specific Scholarship. A maximum of 10 points will be deducted if the essays are ‘copied’ and/or do NOT meet these criteria.**
4. **10%** - List and describe any community wide involvement (civic clubs, church, special events, etc), by year, in each – this should include a minimum of ten (10) hours of community volunteer service – **not 4-H or school related.**
5. **15%** - Describe your involvement, by year, specifically, **in your 4-H / FFA Club**, include number of years, positions/offices held, etc.
6. **20%** - Thoroughness, completeness, formatting, and neatness of application. This includes proper grammar, punctuation, formatting and the complete packet requirements laid out above including your **formal** recommendation letters & report card.

**** Criteria adds to 95% prior to GPA being added.**
